He says he has to learn to get coaching from staff at SAILS like Lorena. He adds, "She is very charming and tough when needed.

A Ramp Was Installed for Mr. Russell Cheramie

Mr. Russell Cheramie is a 90-year-old man from Victoria, TX who came to SAILS seeking a ramp as he was wheelchair bound and unable to exit the home on his own.

Mr. Cheramie was relying on his relatives to assist him but had the goal of achieving more independence, accessibility, and mobility. Through the Complex Rehabilitation Technology Services program, Mr. Cheramie was able to meet this goal.

The day the ramp was installed Mr. Cheramie was so cheerful and excited that he spent 2 ½ hours outside enjoying the fresh air and newfound independence. With this ramp, Mr. Cheramie will not have to rely on relatives to assist him when going outside and will be able to enjoy more time outdoors with friends and family.

When asked for a quote Mr. Cheramie stated "Thanks to SAILS I have the freedom to go outside and have nice evenings outdoors. The ramp gives me the ability to independently get in and out of the house. Thank you SAILS!" Mr. Cheramie's family members have expressed their gratitude towards SAILS and the IL Specialist. They happy to see Mr. Cheramie in high spirits reaching his goals of independence.

Vehicle Modifications For Mr. Robert Shughart

Mr. Robert Shughart was assisted by SAILS-Waco in obtaining a vehicle modification for hand controls and a lift for his scooter.

He is a 68- year-old man from Belton, of Bell County Texas. Mr. Shughart was struggling with mobility due to having both legs amputated and not being able to drive anymore. He had trouble using public transportation due to the many stops they would make and not being able to accommodate his scooter. After receiving help from his independent living specialist, he struggled mentally learning how to cope with his new lifestyle of "mobility" again, Mr. Shughart stated.

"I'm able to drive INDEPENDENTLY!!! I'm able to do my own shopping and pick out the things I want. This vehicle modification has truly changed and saved my life. I was so depressed being in the house these past two years. Now I can just get in my own vehicle and go!! Thank you very much SAILS, you guys are Life Savers!!!"
